ZONING:

Shannon Lee, Zoning Administrator met with the board to discuss Zoning department business. Knebel moved, Schuller seconded to approve building permits for the following applicants: Kyle & Tomi Hagen, Glen Behnke, Mary Freudenthal, Billinda & Mitchell Lemnus, Norm Nitro, Westwood Colony, David Gamber, and Nathan O'Brien. All members present voted aye.

COUNTY VEHICLE:

Shannon Lee met with the board to discuss the vehicle that is usually used by the Zoning department. The board asked that Lee look in to a replacement vehicle and get a trade-in estimate on the current vehicle.

HIGHWAY:

Dustin Hofland, Highway Superintendent and Sandy Dinger, Highway Secretary met with the board to discuss highway department business. Eric Hamiel, TranSource Truck & Equipment was present for the bid opening for a Tandem Truck Chassis. The following bid was opened and publicly read for the purchase of a 2019 or newer Twin Screw Tandem Diesel Dump Truck, Cab & Chassis: TranSource Truck & Equipment \$117,500.00. Symens moved, Knebel seconded to accept the bid with an order date to be set at a later time. All members present voted aye.

Dinger informed the board that the re-routing of the electrical power to the highway department, Horton and the Airport has been completed.

Hofland reported that he is waiting for approval from TransCanada on a settlement amount for damage done to County roads while cleaning up the oil spill.

The new blade should arrive within the next week at the Highway Department. 2018 Chip Sealing on 16AE (East of Eden) and 01AS is planned to start after July 4.

FUEL QUOTES:

Sandy Dinger received the following quotes for #2 diesel for the Langford, Eden and Veblen shops on May 8: Eden Oil: Langford-2.55, Eden-2.55, Veblen-2.58; Holland Bros. Oil: All locations-2.59. No other quotes were available at the time delivery was needed. Diesel fuel was delivered to the Langford, Eden and Veblen shops by Eden Oil.

RAILROAD:

Symens reported that the Railroad authority plans to pay for blinking yellow lights and Railroad Crossing signs to be installed at the intersection of the railroad and county road 9AN (423rd Ave) between Britton City and Horton, Inc. These will be installed by the Highway department.

LAW ENFORCEMENT CONTRACTS:

Dana Frohling, State's Attorney met with the board to discuss the Law Enforcement Contracts between Marshall County and the towns and cities within the county. Frohling will prepare the contracts and arrange a meeting date for the Law Enforcement Committee to meet. Matt Schuller and Doug Medhaug will represent the County at this meeting.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LICENSES:

No one appeared for the Retail Beverage License Hearing. Schuller moved, Knebel seconded to approve the following beverage license Application: Migration X Outfitter DBA Prairie Sky Ranch (on-off sale) malt beverage. All members present voted aye.
