HIGHWAY:

Dustin Hofland, Highway Superintendent met with the board and Sandy Dinger, Highway Secretary met via Zoom to discuss Highway department business. Hofland reported that the highway department has been working on snow removal as needed. Knebel moved, Jones seconded to declare a 2011 International 7400 SFA 6x4 tandem truck surplus and accept sealed bids for its sale until March 29, when they will be opened and publicly read. All members present voted aye. Hofland informed the board that bridge 46-141-000 on 100th St is currently being reviewed by the DOT and is projected to be let out for bids in April or May. This bridge project has received a BIG grant for \$685,700, or 65% of the projected cost.

Chip Seal bids for 2022 will be opened on April 26. Hofland discussed the project on county road 12GE, 438th avenue (former Eden Township road). The correct pipes for the water lines are still not available, so this project is still on hold. Luttrell moved, Knebel seconded to authorize the vice-chair to sign the Bridge Inspection Program Resolution and to hire IMEG formerly known as Clark Engineering to complete these inspections. All members present voted aye. Per a 6-month review, Knebel moved, Jones seconded to

approve a pay increase from \$15.50/hour to 17.05/hour effective February 27. All members present voted aye.

EXECUTIVE SESSION:

Jones moved, Knebel seconded to enter into executive session to discuss legal matters at 9:45 am. All members present voted aye. The Vice-Chair called the board out of executive session at 10:23 am. No action was taken.

Luttrell moved, Jones seconded to enter into executive session to discuss personnel issues at 10:24 am. All members present voted aye. The Vice-Chair called the board out of executive session at 11:53 am. No action was taken.
