ORDINANCE NO.62 ESTABLISHING PERMANENT FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION REGULATIONS FOR MARSHALL COUNTY SOUTH DAKOTA, PROVIDING FOR THE ADMINISTRATION, ENFORCEMENT, AND AMENDMENTS THEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

Marshall County is adopting this ordinance in order to protect the public health, safety, and general welfare.
