PUBLIC COMMENT:

HIGHWAY:

Dustin Hofland, Highway Superintendent met with the board to discuss Highway Department Business. Hofland reported that the State has accepted the Highway Department 5-year plan and the fuel system at the highway shop is still being worked on.

FUEL QUOTES:

Sandy Dinger received the following quotes for #2 diesel for the Britton shop on October 21: DaMar Elevator \$2.65; Eden Oil \$2.63; Full Circle Ag \$2.679. Diesel fuel was delivered to the Britton Shop by Eden Oil.

COURTHOUSE ASBESTOS REPORT:

The board reviewed the asbestos survey from Geotek for the Targeted Brownsfield Assessment that was completed on the Marshall County Courthouse. The complete survey can be viewed on the Marshall County website. There were 4 areas found where asbestos (greater that 1%) containing floor tiles were found. These tiles contained 2-3% asbestos. Removal of any materials containing greater than 1% asbestos is recommended if they will be affected by the renovation, as the dust particles in the air from disturbing these items during renovation can be a concern. As a part of the Brownsfield grant from the state, these floor tiles will be removed. The County has also requested that the vermiculite that was found in the attic also be removed, although it was not found to contain greater than 1% asbestos. This request was approved.

SURPLUS:

Medhaug moved, Knebel seconded to declare a 2015 Ford Explorer VIN 1FM5K8AR7FGC17391 surplus and offer it for sale to the public through sealed bids. All members voted aye.

RESIGNATION:

The board accepted the resignation of deputy sheriff Ian MacDonald, effective November 15, 2024.

COUNTY EMPLOYEE HEALTH INSURANCE:

The board discussed the County employee health insurance benefit. No action was taken.

FUTURE MEETINGS:

The board set the following dates for future Commission meetings: November 7 & 21; December 10 & 31.
