**PUBLIC COMMENT:**

No one was present to make public comment.

**MARSHALL COUNTY FOOD PANTRY:**

Marie and Russell Marlow met with the board regarding moving the food pantry into the area that was previously used by the County Health Nurse in the Community Building. Bender will look into which areas are covered by the generator in the Community Building and will speak with the Sheriff's/E911 departments regarding the rooms currently being used for their back up equipment.

**HIGHWAY:**

Dustin Hofland, Highway Superintendent met with the board to discuss Highway department business. Hofland stated the project on State Highway 27 is expected to begin in the next few years. They plan to possibly use county roads 7, 12 & 14 as detours. Eden Town has requested to shut down county road 16 through town during the last weekend in June for their Eden Days celebration.

Jerry Burger asked the board to review a location where he feels a culvert should be placed in 418<sup>th</sup> Avenue and county road 6. Burger also asked for an update on the Wade bridge, Hofland stated that he has not heard any updates. The project is expected to begin in June or July.

Burger asked about a culvert North of Langford in County Road 9. Hofland stated he is aware of the issue and that the road will need to be repaired, but the appropriate culverts cannot be ordered for approximately 6 weeks.

The highway superintendent has the discretion to hire any of the approved bidders taking into consideration location, material, need and availability. All members voted aye.

Medhaug moved, Bender seconded to also use the bid from Beadle County for the year's supply of Metal Pipe and Bridge material. True North Steel received the culvert bid as being the lowest bidder and in the best interest of Beadle County. All members voted aye.

**HIGHWAY (Continued):**

Hofland discussed upcoming projects for the year, including the chip seal on county roads 1, 2 & 4, the Game Fish and Parks contribution to repair approximately 4 miles of County road 5, the Wade bridge, and the 3 bridges that the County has grants for the preliminary engineering. The board also discussed the railroad crossing in County Road 4 near Kidder. State's Attorney Rapkoch will work with Hofland to draft a resolution reducing the speed in this area.

**EXECUTIVE SESSION:**

Medhaug moved, Luttrell seconded to enter into executive session pursuant to SDCL 1-25-22 (4) for contract negotiations at 10:38 am. All members voted aye. The chairman called the board out of executive session at 11:27 am. No action was taken.

**LEGISLATIVE AUDIT:**

Kasie Ingraham, Legislative Audit met with the board via teleconference regarding Marshall County's 2024-2025 Audit. Kilker moved, Medhaug seconded to authorize the chair to sign the letter of engagement from the Department of Legislative Audit to begin the Audit. All members voted aye.

**NORTH MARSHALL FIRE:**

The board discussed contributing to the North Marshall Fire Department for the use of their meeting room for 41 meetings while construction was taking place at the Courthouse. Bender moved, Medhaug seconded to donate \$2,000 to the Fire Department. All members voted aye.

**PAY RAISE:**

Kilker moved, Medhaug seconded authorize a COLA raise for Bill Deutsch to 20.60/hour effective March 8, Bailee Yule to 20.60/hour effective February 22, and Kassi Jones to 20.60/hour effective March 29, upon completion of their 6-month probationary period. All members voted aye.

**RESIGNATION:**

The board accept the resignation of Slade Owen, Deputy Sheriff, effective March 31, 2026.

**NEW HIRE:**

Kristin Pester was hired as full-time Cleaning Personnel for the Courthouse and Community building effective March 2 at 18.50/hour.

**EXECUTIVE SESSION:**

Bender moved, Luttrell seconded to enter into executive session pursuant to SDCL 1-25-22 (1) at 11:42 to discuss personnel issues. All members voted aye. The chairman called the board out of executive session at 11:59. No action was taken.

**ADJOURN:**

Medhaug moved, Kilker seconded to adjourn. All members voted aye.
